DETAILS

Your toolbox must not contain undeclared goods if travelling by air. The following are some examples of dangerous goods that may be present in tool boxes:

- Cigarette lighter, refills
- Matches
- Gas soldering equipment (eg. Butane soldering pens or blow torches)
- Aerosol cans (eg. WD40, CRC)
- Flammable solvents (eg. Turpentine, methylated spirits, paint thinners)
- Flammable adhesives
- Resin kits
- Paint
- Explosive nails, rivets or ammunition
- Lithium type batteries (either lithium metal/lithium ion or lithium polymer) If they are spares they must travel in your carry on / if in equipment they must not be able to activate
- Any other hazardous material, Ask check-in staff if any tools or equipment has a diamond shaped hazard label affixed to it.

If in doubt, ask!

For air transport, remove these items, or transport by road.
